

HOW TO PRONOUNCE SHORT VOWELS AND LONG VOWELS:

Vowels become a long vowel when followed by a consonant and then another vowel. (모음 + 자음 + 모음)

Example: tale, bake, pride, froze, hope, nude, eve, gene, scene, etc.

Y is a vowel when it's one syllable. Example: Lynn, cry, dye, Mary. It is typically considered a consonant when at the front of a word. Example: Yard, yes, you, young etc. However, it is sounded as a long vowel when at the end of the word.
